



Rhossili Circular Walk



This beautiful walk begins in the village of Rhossili, along one of Wales' best beaches, before climbing to the top of Cefn Bryn hillside for spectacular panoramic views. We then descend back to the village, with an option to continue walking around the headland to Fall Bay, or to finish there.

Distance: 4 miles (if finishing at Rhossili) / 7 miles (if continuing for full walk)

Ascent: 220 metres / 290 metres

Approximate time: 3 hours / 5 hours

Terrain: Lanes, rocky paths, sand, muddy / boggy ground / grass, steep slopes and steps

Parking / refreshments / facilities: Plenty of parking at Rhossili (card payment – National Trust members park for free). Toilets in Rhossili and Hill End (half way point), food & drink in Rhossili.

Kit requirements: Every participant needs to wear walking boots (with ankle support – not trainers) and have a waterproof coat & overtrousers. A small backpack with 2 litres of water, snacks, sun protection, warm layers and any personal medication etc. Walking poles can be useful.
